
### **Artwork Production Guidelines**

When creating your artwork, please follow the guidelines below.

#### Recycled Artwork Production Guidelines

- 1. Creators: Individual or group junior high school students.
  - Note 1: Students can participate both as an individual and in a group.
  - Note 2: Each group is limited to <u>5 students</u>.
- 2. Number of artworks: Up to <u>2 artworks</u> per individual or group.
- 3. Size of artworks: Each side should be less than <u>1 meter</u> in size.
- 4. Theme of artworks: Nothing in particular.
- 5. Category of artworks: Nothing specified. \* All artworks will be judged together.
- 6. Materials for the artworks: There are no particular restrictions.
  - Note 1: The materials must be considered as "garbage."
  - Note 2: The materials are <u>not hazardous materials</u>.
- 7. Storage of artworks: Each participant is responsible for storage. The artworks themselves will not be moved or sent.



## Recycled Artwork Judging Data Guidelines

- 1. Judging of artworks: Artworks will be <u>judged based only on the judging data</u>, not on physical pieces.
- 2. Data for judging: Creators (individuals or groups) must submit data for judging.
- 3. Deadline for submitting data of artworks: August 31

- 4. Judging period: during September
- 5. Types of data for judging: <u>3 types</u> of data will be submitted: <u>document data</u>, <u>photo data</u>, and video data.
- 6. Document data: Submit a document that details your artwork.
  - Explain the title of the artwork, materials used, etc. in a format that follows.
  - Submit online of the format.
- 7. Photo Data: Submit photos that detail your artwork.
  - Photos should be submitted online as files, with <u>no more than 10 photos.</u>
  - Photograph the piece from different angles to show its details.
  - Include photos of <u>the materials used.</u>
- 8. Video Data: Submit a video that explains the details of your artwork.
  - One video file, no more than <u>2 minutes</u>, submitted online.
  - Photograph the piece from different angles to show its details.
  - Adding the production process is recommended.
  - Texts, music and voice can be added.
  - The creator's appearance (facial expression) cannot be included. (Hands, etc. are allowed.)
- 9. How to submit data for judging: Upload data online.
  - ① <u>Link information</u> of the upload folder will be announced to each participant.
  - ② Each upload folder can be used only by the participant.
  - ③ Upload all data to the linked folder by August 31.
  - ④ Participant can edit or change data in the linked folder by August 31.
- 10. Online interview: If necessary, the judges may conduct an online interview with the creator.
