How to enter the contest

- 1. Participate as an individual or in a group (Maximum number of students in a group: <u>5 students</u>)
- 2. Students need to apply first, then they create artworks.
- 3. Submit the work by the deadline (submissions will be made online).
- 4. Each individual or group can create <u>2 artworks</u>.
- 5. Photographs and videos will be taken of the works in order to judge them. Also the form to describe the artwork needs to be filled. (Photos: less than 10 files, Video: 1 file within 2 minutes)
 - *The details of the artwork data format will be announce to participants.
- 6. Size of the artwork must be up to about 1 meter on each side.
- 7. Materials used in the artworks is not limited.
 - *As far as the materials are recognized as "garbage".
 - *Hazardous materials are not allowed.
- 8. There is no specific theme for the artworks at this contest.
- 9. There is no specific categories for artworks. All artworks will be judged together.

Contest Judging Method

- 1. The artwork itself will not be moved or sent (kept at home or at school).
- 2. The entries will be judged based on photos and videos and the form of the works.
- 3. Creators record their presentations and explanations of their artworks on photos and videos and the form.
- 4. Creators present and explain their artworks online during the judging process.
- 5. <u>2 judges</u> will be selected from each country (mainly school staff).
- 6. If there are a large number of applications, there will be <u>a first round of judging in each country</u>, and then only the top artworks will be judged in the international contest.
- 7. The <u>top three works</u> from each country and the <u>top three overall</u> will be selected in the end.
- 8. The top artworks will be awarded certificates and prizes.
- 9. All artworks will be introduced online (on official websites).
- 10. The judging results will be announced and awards will be presented online at the video call ceremony. October 13th (Monday),

Contest Management

1. Organize a committee of students.

- 2. The <u>Management Committee</u> will be formed consisting of staff from each country.
- 3. The **Student Committee** will include several students from each country.
- 4. The contest will be basically planned and managed by the Student Committee.
- 5. The Student Committee will be held regularly via video call.
- 6. The Student Committee will share information and hold discussions via SNS (Teams).
- 7. The Management Committee will make the final decision.
- 8. The Management Committee shares information and makes decisions via SNS (Messenger).

Contest operation costs

- 1. The production costs of the artwork are generally borne by the artist oneself.
- 2. Participation is <u>free of charge</u>.
- 3. Photography and videography will be done by the artist or the organizers.
- 4. Certificates and prizes of international contest part (not domestic part) are prepared by NPO Supratarka.
