Activity

We realized that it is not easy at all to keep peace around the world with the reality of what is happening in Ukraine and other places. Then it is worthwhile for students to consider world peace and exchange ideas together.

Through the exchange of opinions and ideas, students will develop their understanding of each other and of the world.

1. Develop students' understanding of the world.
2. Develop children's worldwide network.
3. Develop students' communication skills.
4. Provide opportunities for global communication.
5. Develop students' leadership skills.

Preparation

1. **Each side** prepares introduction of their own school.
 - Introduce your school with photos and diagrams.
 - Add current situation of Coronavirus.
 - Select presenter(s) of your school.
 - Presentation should be within 2 minutes at each side.
2. **Each student** prepares one's own idea(s) for the theme **“Let's invent a way to make world peace!”** in advance.
 - Idea(s) should be clear and concrete.
 - Idea(s) doesn't have to be actually possible.
 - Idea(s) shouldn't be some kind of magic.
 - Use diagrams to explain your idea (invention) clearly.
3. **Each side** prepares two ideas for the theme **“Let's invent a way to make world peace!”**.
 - Develop their ideas and decide two ideas as your group ideas.
 - Prepare presentation for those two ideas.
 - Ideas should be clear and concrete.
 - Use diagrams to explain it clearly.
 - Ideas can be prepared in their own language.
 - Use short sentences so that it can be easily translated into English.
 - Each presentation should be within 2 minutes because of translation.
4. **Each student** prepares school items to show.
 - Text books or notebooks or art works are fine, so that we can compare the difference between countries.
 - Prepare some items so that everyone can show different items.
5. **Presenter(s)** for your school introduction.
 - Select student(s) as presenter(s).
6. **Presenters** to present your group ideas.

- Select two students as presenters. (Two ideas)
7. **Translators** need to understand the flow of translation, because all gather on the same screen at the same time. They need to translate one by one sequentially.

Conference Rules

1. All participating students are expected to ask questions or express opinions.
2. **Do not criticize other's ideas or opinions** by own standards. Constructive questions or opinions are welcomed.

 → Translator 2 (native language 2) → Students

Questioner (native language)

→ Translator (English) → [\[Internet\]](#)
 → Translator 1 (native language 1) → Speaker
 → Translator 2 (native language 2) → Speaker

Role list at the conference

- Conference manager: hosts and controls and facilitates the entire activity.
- Group managers (translators): Teachers. (Each country has one manager who takes care of their students.)
- Conference staff: support the conference and the conference manager.

Notes

- Please select students according to their ideas and will. Students should not be selected according to their English ability only. The aim is not English conversation but to discuss and exchange ideas beyond country borders.
